NOTICE TO THE CREDITORS OF SHIFT NETWORKS INC.
(referred to as “Shift”)

In the matter of the Companies’ Creditors Arrangement Act (“CCAA”) and Shift.

On May 8, 2007 Shift received protection under the CCAA from the Alberta Court of Queen’s Bench. PricewaterhouseCoopers Inc. (“PwC”) was named Monitor.

PwC, in its capacity as Monitor, has agreed to assist Shift to solicit claims from all creditors of Shift for the purpose of determining the claims which will participate in the CCAA proceedings.

Any creditor having a claim against Shift is required to file a Notice of Claim with PwC in the prescribed form in order to participate in any voting or distributions associated with the CCAA proceedings.

Any creditor who chooses to file a Notice of Claim is required to provide whatever supporting documentation they may have, such as bills of lading, shipping receipts or transportation invoices in relation to the goods and/or services in support of their claim as at May 8, 2007.

A Claims Bar Date of 5:00pm Calgary time on July 31, 2007 has been set by the Alberta Court of Queen’s Bench. All claims received by the Monitor or postmarked after the Claims’ Bar Date will, unless otherwise ordered by the Alberta Court of Queen’s Bench, be forever extinguished, barred and will not participate in any voting or distributions in the CCAA proceedings. All claims must be made on or before the Claims’ Bar Date as follows:

- (i) Claims of any nature, including both unsecured and secured claims, against Shift.
- (ii) All claims must be reduced to reflect the value of any equipment and/or other assets released by Shift to the creditors whether by court order or otherwise.
- (iii) Where a creditor of Shift is claiming an offset against all or a portion of amounts owing by Shift, full particulars of the offset must be included.

All claims must be made in the prescribed “Notice of Claim” form together with the required supporting documentation and be postmarked or received by the Monitor on or before the Claims Bar Date; namely July 31, 2007 at PricewaterhouseCoopers Inc., 3100, 111 – 5th Avenue SW, Calgary, Alberta, T2P 5L3, to the attention of Ms. Brenda Kuryk. Notice to Creditors are to be sent to all known creditors by ordinary mail on or before June 13, 2007. The prescribed “Notice of Claim” form can be obtained by contacting the Monitor at (403) 509 7381 or can be downloaded from the Monitor’s website at www.pwc.com/brs-shift.

The Monitor will accumulate the Notice of Claim forms and transmit them to Shift. Where the claim is disallowed in whole or in part, Shift will issue a Notice of Disallowance ("Notice of Disallowance") indicating the reasons for the disallowance by no later than August 15, 2007. Where a creditor objects to a disallowance, the creditor shall notify Shift of the objection in writing by registered mail, courier service or facsimile within fourteen (14) days of issuance of the Notice of Disallowance. The creditor shall serve on Shift a Notice of Motion to the Alberta Court of Queen's Bench, returnable within seven (7) days after the notice of objection, for the determination of the disallowed claim. The said Notice of Motion may be adjourned by the agreement of the parties or the Alberta Court of Queen's Bench to a suitable hearing date.
