And further take notice that the Court of Appeal will be moved at the hearing of this application for an order that:

- (a) the Appellant is no longer required to continue to supply goods to the Respondents on credit, pursuant to the order of the Honourable Mr. Justice Sewell pronounced February 6, 2012 (the "Critical Suppliers Order"); and
- (b) costs.

The grounds of appeal are:

- (a) the learned Chambers Judge erred in law by holding that the Appellant's leave to have the Critical Supplier's Order revisited was limited to whether the Petitioners required continued credit from the Appellant and the others, and that the other provisions set out in the Critical Suppliers Order were *res judicata*;
- (b) the learned Chambers Judge erred in law by applying the incorrect test in deciding whether to grant relief pursuant to section 11.4 of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*, and the learned Chambers Judge did not have jurisdiction to grant such relief on the facts before him; and
- (c) in the alternative, the learned Chambers Judge erred in law by failing to properly exercise the statutory discretion under sections 11 and 11.4 of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* in a manner consistent with the scheme and objects of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*.

The hearing of this proceeding occupied 1 day.
