INTERLOCUTORY APPLICATION (inter partes) OF CIT FINANCIAL LTD.

The Interlocutory Application (Inter Partes) of CIT Financial Ltd. ("CIT") states:

- 1. By Order of this Honourable Court all secured creditors of Hickman Equipment (1985) Limited, in Bankruptcy and Court Ordered Receivership (referred to herein as "HEL" or "Hickman Equipment") were required to make application for the proceeds of sale of heavy equipment over which they believe they have a priority security interest from Hickman Equipment, the majority of such heavy equipment having been disposed of by the Receiver/Trustee for Hickman Equipment and identifiable proceeds retained in substitution therefore.
- By Application dated January 15, 2003 under Court Sub-File Number 7:33A CIT applied for the proceeds of sale of five Terex trucks, identified in Schedule "A" hereto (the "Application").
- This Honourable Court ordered that any creditor of Hickman Equipment who opposes an Application for Proceeds by another secured creditor of HEL file a Notice of Objection thereto.
- 4. A Notice of Objection of General Motors Acceptance Corporation of Canada ("GMAC") dated February 7, 2003 was filed with this Honourable Court (the "GMAC Objection").
- The GMAC Objection opposes the Application, claiming that GMAC has a first priority interest in all of the five Terex Trucks with the exception of the Terex Truck with Serial Number A7761188 (the remaining Terex Trucks referred to herein as the "Terex Trucks") by virtue of:
 - (a) Leasing Inventory Chattel Mortgages (the "Chattel Mortgages") and
 - (b) A Security Agreement (Leasing) (the "Security Agreement").
- 6. By Application under Court Sub-file Number 7:21 GMAC made application for the proceeds of the Terex Trucks, claiming a prior security interest therein (the "GMAC Application"). The GMAC Application was heard on January 23 and 24, 2003 and a decision of this Honourable Court was rendered on February 20, 2003 (the "GMAC Decision").
- 7. The GMAC Application was for the express purpose of determining whether GMAC had a prior security interest in the Terex Trucks.
- 8. Prior to and during the GMAC Application, GMAC expressly waived and/or abandoned any reliance upon the Security Agreement.
- 9. The GMAC Decision determined that GMAC did not have a security interest in the Terex Trucks having priority to CIT's security interest, and the GMAC Decision expressly noted GMAC's waiver of reliance upon the Security Agreement.
- 10. The Applicant states that the issue of GMAC's priority interest in the Terex Trucks has been expressly dealt with by this Honourable Court and it has been determined that the Chattel Mortgages do not afford a priority interest to GMAC. Such decision is the subject matter of an appeal before the Newfoundland Supreme Court, Court of Appeal.
- 11. At all times relevant to the GMAC Application, GMAC's reliance upon the Security Agreement for purposes of affording it a priority security interest over the Terex Trucks was abandoned.
- 12. The Applicant further states that any attempt by GMAC to "reopen" its argument of prior entitlement to the Terex Trucks pursuant to the Security Agreement is prohibited by Res Judicata.

13. The Applicant therefore applies for an order requiring that GMAC amend its Notice of Objection to remove reliance upon the Security Agreement as affording it a security interest in the Terex Trucks which has priority to CIT.
