AND IN THE MATTER OF the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, Chapter B-3 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1985, as amended (the "BIA")

INTERLOCUTORY APPLICATION (Inter Partes)

The Application of Tramac Equipment Ltd. ("Tramac"), the Applicant herein, says that:

1. By Order of this Court dated March 13, 2002 and filed March 14, 2002, PricewaterhouseCoopers Inc. ("PWC") was appointed Receiver of the assets of Hickman Equipment (the "Receivership Order").
2. By further Order of this Court dated March 13, 2002 and filed March 14, 2002, Hickman Equipment was adjudged bankrupt and PWC was appointed as Trustee of the estate of the bankruptcy (the "Receiving Order").
3. By further Order of this Court dated May 14, 2002 and filed May 17, 2002, PWC's plan for the realization of the assets of Hickman Equipment was approved (the "Realization Plan Order").
4. The Realization Plan Order approved PWC's plan for the determination of the rights and entitlement of creditors and claimants to the assets of Hickman Equipment (the "Claims Plan").
5. Under paragraphs 6 and 7 of the Claims Plan, the determination of the rights and entitlement of creditors and claimants to the assets of Hickman Equipment involved a two stage process, as follows:
 - (a) A determination of whether a claimant had a valid, perfected and enforceable ownership or security interests in the assets of Hickman Equipment or the proceeds arising therefrom; and
 - (b) A determination of the priority of a claimant's interests *vis-à-vis* other claimants.
6. Under paragraph 20 of the Claims Plan, PWC proposed that the order of priority of claims to an asset of Hickman Equipment or to the proceeds arising therefrom

be determined using the priority rules established by the *Personal Property Security Act*, S.N.L. 1998, c. P-7.1 ("PPSA") and other applicable law.

7. Under paragraph 21 of the Claims Plan, issues of priority and entitlement to collateral between secured claimants may, upon Application, be brought before this Court for determination, pursuant to the provisions of Section 68 of the PPSA.
8. Tramac presented its security interest claim to PWC (the "Tramac Claim").
9. The Tramac Claim dealt with one Tramac product as follows (the "Tramac Rock Drill Attachment"):

10. PWC sold the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment as part of the realization of the assets of Hickman Equipment.
11. The proceeds arising from the sale of the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment totaled \$62,000.00.
12. PWC issued its Final Determination of the Tramac Claim on November 8, 2002 and allowed the Tramac Claim as a valid secured claim.
13. PWC has not made any determination as to Tramac's priority or entitlement to the proceeds arising from the sale of the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment.
14. Tramac therefore applies, pursuant to paragraph 21 of the Claims Plan and Section 68 of the PPSA, (i) for a determination of the priority and entitlement of Tramac, *vis-à-vis* other claimants, to the proceeds from the sale of the Tramac

Rock Drill Attachment, and (ii) for an order that PWC pay the proceeds from the sale of the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment to Tramac.

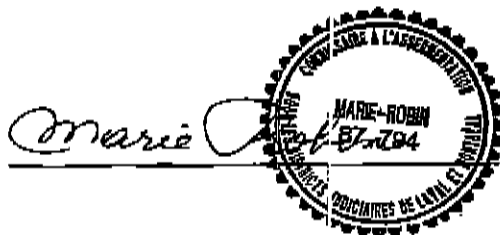
AFFIDAVIT

4. Now produced and shown to me and marked as Exhibit SP#1 to this my Affidavit is a copy of the Consignment Purchase Order.
5. Pursuant to the Consignment Purchase Order, Tramac delivered a Tramac CPA 225 Rock Drill Attachment, serial # 129379 (the "Tramac Rock Drill Attachment"), to Hickman Equipment for sale or lease on consignment.
6. Now produced and shown to me and marked as Exhibit SP#2 to this my Affidavit is a copy of a Tramac Rock Drill Attachments brochure showing and describing a Tramac CPA 225 Rock Drill Attachment of the same type as the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment.
7. By my fax message dated April 30, 2001 to Edward Head of Hickman Equipment and pursuant to the Consignment Purchase Order, I provided Hickman Equipment with pricing information for the sale of the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment.
8. Now produced and shown to me and marked as Exhibit SP#3 to this my Affidavit is a copy of my April 30, 2001 fax message to Edward Head of Hickman Equipment.
9. By my fax message dated May 15, 2001 to Edward Head of Hickman Equipment and pursuant to the Consignment Purchase Order, I provided Hickman Equipment with pricing information for the lease of the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment.

10. Now produced and shown to me and marked as Exhibit SP#4 to this my Affidavit is a copy of my fax message of May 15, 2001 to Edward Head of Hickman Equipment.
11. In my fax message of May 15, 2001 to Edward Head of Hickman Equipment, I asked Mr. Head to confirm the Consignment Purchase Order for rental of the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment at \$12,000.00 per month.
12. On July 9, 2001, I received a fax of the Consignment Purchase Order from Edward Head of Hickman Equipment, on which Edward Head confirmed the rental of the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment at \$12,000.00 per month and the rental start date of May 22, 2001 (the "Amended Consignment Purchase Order").
13. Now produced and shown to me and marked as Exhibit SP#5 to this my Affidavit is a copy of the Amended Consignment Purchase Order.
14. On January 21, 2002, Tramac caused to be registered in the Atlantic PPRS a PPSA Financing Statement relating to the Tramac Rock Drill Attachment (the "Tramac PPSA Financing Statement").
15. Now produced and shown to me and marked as Exhibit SP#6 to this my Affidavit is a copy of the Atlantic PPRS Verification Statement of the Tramac PPSA Financing Statement.
