2009 Scholarship Application

Who?

Are you a bright young Caymanian who is...

- academically sound
- wanting to pursue a career in public accounting
- well-rounded, as evidenced by community involvement, sporting or extra-curricular activities
- of good character and integrity
- ambitious
- committed to your pursuits

You should possess at least 5 GCE/CXC passes with a minimum grade of C or 3, or a high school diploma with at least a 3.0 GPA or equivalent over the last two years of study and a combined SAT score of not less than 1500 (if you are studying overseas).

What?

Local Study: You could be funded to complete an Associate's degree or a Bachelor's of Accountancy at either of the local tertiary education institutions.

PwC will award up to a total of CI\$5,000 for each of the first two years of the Associate's degree, and up to a total of CI\$8,500 per year for the Bachelor of Accountancy.

Upon completion of an Associate's degree, you may apply for funding with us to attend an approved university overseas to complete a degree sufficient to qualify for writing the Certified Public Accountant Examination.

Overseas Study: Applicants for sponsorship at this level are generally expected to be currently enrolled at a suitable university overseas or to have completed an Associate's degree in preparation. In certain exceptional cases, PwC will consider applications from students attending university for the first time.

You can apply for a maximum of US\$30,000 per year.

When?

Your application should be received at our offices by Friday May 15th, 2009. We will review all application packages and interview potential candidates in late May and into early June. If you are unsuccessful, you will receive notification by mail or email.

How?

Here's what you need to include in your application package...

- Cover letter giving details of your background, career aspirations and community involvement
- Essay detailing why you consider yourself deserving of this scholarship from PricewaterhouseCoopers
- An official high school or university transcript of your most recent academic year
- Two character references * *Please ensure that references are current and from two different non-family sources*
- Proof of Caymanian citizenship
- Detailed Resumé, accompanied by any certificates
