The Law on compulsory health insurance funds for 2009

The Parliament of Moldova has adopted the Law on compulsory health insurance funds for 2009 (No. 263 - XVI of 19 December 2008).

Among others, the Law establishes special provisions regarding:

- the compulsory health insurance premium, calculated as a percentage of salary and other payments, is established at 7% (i.e. 3.5% for the employer and 3.5% employees)
- the compulsory health insurance premium calculated as a fixed amount is established as 2,637.60 MDL .

The Law entered into force on 1 January 2009.
