Order 903/2009 was issued on 22 May 2009 approving the model of the Declaration on the work schedule of ethyl alcohol / distillates factories and the instructions for preparing the schedule ("Order"). The Order replaces and abolishes Order 716 dated 25 April 2008.

Main changes:

- From 25 May 2009, the Authorisation Directorate of the National Customs Authority is authorised to approve the work schedule.
- The work schedules approved by the entry into force of the Order remain valid for the period for which they were approved.
- From 25 May 2009, General Directorate of Tax Inspection Coordination within National Agency for Fiscal Administration is also in charge with the surveillance and control of ethyl alcohol and distillates' production, together with Counties and Bucharest Directorates for Excise and Customs Operations, Excise and Customs Operations Surveillance Department of National Customs Authority and the Financial Guard.
