The vice-president of the National Agency for Tax Administration has issued Order no. 7,841/10.12.2008 amending and supplementing the Technical Norms regulating the Export Control System, previously approved by Order no. 6,632/2007.

Some of the major changes are:

1. New documents supporting the closure of the export regime have been introduced (previously, only the export accompanying document (EAD) was accepted). For example, the customs declarant may file:
 - a copy of the delivery voucher signed and authenticated by the consignee outside the Community Customs Territory; or
 - a document certified by the customs authorities of a Member State or of a country outside the Customs Community Territory.
2. The deadline for submitting the documents supporting the export regime is extended from 120 days to 150 days from the date the customs clearance is granted for the goods to be exported.
