The ECS-RO is now used to declare all goods destined to leave the customs territory of the European Community.

The exceptions previously noted in our Tax & Legal Alert dated 9 July 2007 no longer apply.

Paper-based customs returns are now used only if the ECS-RO system is not working.

Export Accompanying Documents (“EAD”) on paper do not have to be stamped by the exit customs office.

These amendments were brought by Order No. 1,626, approved by the vice-president of the National Agency of Fiscal Administration (“Order”), establishing the technical norms for using the Export Control System.

The Order entered into force on 1 July 2009 and abolished Order No 6,632/2007.
