

### Hog Sty Bay George Town, Grand Cayman



In its early history, George Town was known as the 'Hogsties', presumably because enclosures for pigs were located there. To this day, the waterfront carries the name 'Hog Sty Bay'. Archaeologists have uncovered old fresh water wells (step wells) in the area, indicating that passing ships stopped to fill their water casks there.
