Internal auditors' primary task is to provide assurance that enhances the governance, risk management and control processes of an organisation; and the primary medium of communication is through the written report.

The challenge for many audit teams is how to raise and communicate the results of the audit in such a way that it addresses the root issue and therefore makes a positive impact on the governance, risk management and control processes of the organisation.
