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Quotas on grain export are cancelled

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Quotas on grain export are cancelled

On 4 June 2011, the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine cancelling grain quotas (wheat, barley) came into force. As the quotas for export of maize were cancelled in early May, only quotas for the export of rye and buckwheat will remain.

As we already informed, the Parliament of Ukraine adopted the law on introducing customs duties on the export of grain, barley and maize. The President has not yet signed this law.
