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Free Trade Agreement between EFTA states and Ukraine

On 24 June 2010, Ukraine signed a free trade agreement (FTA) with the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) which includes Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland.

The FTA provides for exemption from customs duty of goods traded between these countries. It also covers trade in services, investments, intellectual property rights, government procurement and enforcement of competition law.

The FTA will have to be ratified by the respective Parliaments and will enter into force after exchange of ratification instruments.
