Parliament has passed a law "On judicial system and status of judges". This law is aimed at reforming the judicial system of Ukraine and simplifying legal procedures.

The law introduces a number of amendments to all procedural codes of Ukraine, including the administrative procedural code, which is applied to disputes between taxpayers and state authorities.

Among the major amendments are: reductions of various procedural terms (i.e. a limitation period for the submission of a court claim) and changes regarding appeal claims and cassation claims.

The law also reduces the terms of consideration for court cases.

Major amendments specified in the law will enter into force starting July 15.

Should you have current or potential litigations, we recommend assessing your deadlines and tactics in light of this new law.
