### The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine has amended the procedure to obtain a work permit for foreigners ("WP")

The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine issued Resolution\* which introduced amendments into the effective Order of issuance, prolongation and cancellation of the WP\*\*, namely:

- Extended (clarified) the list of categories for employees who are eligible for WPs (i.e. graduates from highly ranked universities);
- Reduced the time period for:
  - Examination of documents by the authorities (from 15 to 7 working days) and
  - Submission of documents for prolongation period (from 30 to 20 calendar days).

We believe that overall the changes will improve the procedure to obtain a work permit.

We will continue to monitor the situation and keep you informed on any updates.
