

Practical training aimed at preparing your organization to handle cybersecurity incidents



What is the training about?

- The training is aimed at preparing organizations to handle cybersecurity incidents and minimise damage. It covers both, organizational and technical aspects, and it is based on IST Cybersecurity Incident handling guide (NIST.SP.800-61), as well as practical experience of the trainers of handling real incidents.
- The training covers roles and responsibilities of the incident response team (including roles of the top management).
- From the technical standpoint the training covers emergency security measures, and post-incident activities aimed at cleansing organization's systems, network and Active Directory after an attack.
- This includes elements of computer forensics and incident investigation, including use of specialized tools such as SIEM, IDS/IPS, Sandboxes (as well as use of freely distributed SNORT and YARA tools).

Whom is the training for?

- The training is aimed at members of the management team and technical staff that will be involved in preparing for and handling of security incident
- The team typically includes CEO, Head of Risk, IT, Security, Operations, Internal Communications and PR, Internal Audit, as well as key technical staff
- The first 1.5 hours are aimed the team as a whole, including top management. During this session we cover organization aspects of incident handling
- The rest of the training (5-6 hours) cover technical measures, including containment and eradication of intruders from the IT systems of your organization.
