1. General overview



- Presidential Decree No. 52/19, of 18 February, approves the General Strategy for the Allocation of Oil Concessions for the period 2019-2025, and provides the guidance for future concessions, either by public tender or by direct negotiation.
- Oil concessions can be attributed by means of (i) public tender ("PT"), (ii) limited public tender ("LPT") and (iii) direct negotiation ("DN"). The above mentioned diploma defines already the attribution procedure applicable to each Oil Concession.

- The diploma establishes and anticipates the tender of more than 50 new Oil & Gas concessions in Offshore, Onshore and Interior Basins, namely:
 - 2019 Blocks in Namibe and Benguela Basins;
 - 2020 Blocks in the Kwanza and Congo Basins;
 - 2021 Offshore Shelf and Deepwater Kwanza and Congo Basins;
 - 2023 Onshore Interior Basins (still to be divided in blocks and therefore excluded from the current program);
 - 2025 Pre-Salt Blocks (also still not included in the current program).
- Concessions for 2020-2025 period will be attributed by PT or by LPT. All DN biddings already occurred in 2019. In 2020, blocks in the Kwanza and Congo Basins will be tendered by PT.



3. Bidding process

Public tender and limited public tender



- In PT model, SONANGOL may acquire a share of at least 20% in the oil concessions and has the right to be funded by up to 20% in new research operations by international associates if it is not an operator.
- The contract be entered with the awarded entity will take the form of an incorporated company, consortium agreement or production sharing agreement.

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
