Amendments to the Law On extradition of offenders

New amendments provide the following:

1.1 Extradition of expatriates or stateless persons residing or staying on the territory of the Republic of Azerbaijan to another state with the aim of prosecution or conviction for the crime committed on the territory of that state should be held in accordance with the Constitution of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Law On extradition of offenders, criminal legislation of Azerbaijan, international agreements signed by the Republic of Azerbaijan and other related legislative acts.

1.2 Principles of the Law On extradition of offenders are applicable in cases when there is no any agreement between the party requesting the extradition of expatriate or stateless person who had committed a crime and the Republic of Azerbaijan, or existing agreement doesn't reflect the relevant issue, provided that implementation of these principles

are not contradicted with the provisions of existing agreement.

Amendments to the Law On legal assistance in criminal cases

The introduced amendments providing that principles of the law On legal assistance in criminal cases are applicable in cases when there is no any agreement between the party requesting the legal assistance and the Republic of Azerbaijan, or existing agreement doesn't reflect the relevant issue, provided that implementation of these principles are not contradicted with the provisions of existing agreement.

Amendments to the Migration Code

Draft law proposes the following addendum to the Article 90.9 of the Migration Code: Complaints regarding the abolition of disciplinary measures, should be immediately concerned by the relevant appeal body on the basis of application of considered party or with the initiative of appeal body itself.
