We are writing to provide an update on the status of the HBHL matter.

Further to the update of 6 March 2026, the Trustee attended the scheduled hearing at the Supreme Court of Barbados on 30 March 2026. The application sought, inter alia, the Court’s approval of the Trustee’s report dated 30 August 2024 so that the Trustee could commence distributions in accordance with the claims as adjudicated therein. We are pleased to report that the order was granted.
