**NOTICE OF FILING, AND NOTICE OF HEARING ON,
PETITIONS FOR RECOGNITION OF A FOREIGN MAIN PROCEEDINGS,
OR ALTERNATIVELY AS FOREIGN NONMAIN PROCEEDINGS,
PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 1515 AND 1517 OF THE
UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY CODE AND RELATED RELIEF**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on April 4, 2019, PricewaterhouseCoopers Inc., LIT (“PWC”), in its capacity as court-appointed receiver (“Receiver”) of (1) Innova Global Ltd., (2) Innova Global Operating Ltd., (3) Innova Global Limited Partnership, (4) 1938247 Alberta Ltd., (5) Innova Global Holdings Limited Partnership, (6) Innova Global Inc. (formerly AEM Emissions Management Inc., formerly ATCO Emissions Management Inc.), (7) Innova Global LLC (formerly AEM Noise Management LLC, formerly ATCO Noise Management LLC), and (8) Braden Manufacturing, L.L.C., filed for each of the above Debtors a Chapter 15 Petition for Recognition of a Foreign Proceeding (Doc. 1), and a Petition for Expedited Hearing and Recognition as Foreign Main Proceedings, or Alternatively as Foreign Nonmain Proceedings, Pursuant to Sections 1515 and 1517 of the United States Bankruptcy Code and Related Relief (Doc. 4) (“Recognition Petitions”).

On April 5, 2019, this Court granted the Receiver’s request for an expedited hearing. Accordingly, a hearing on the Recognition Petitions shall be held on **April 18, 2019, at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 1, 224 South Boulder, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74103**. Any objection or response to the Recognition Petitions shall be in writing, in compliance with the Bankruptcy Code and Rules, and the Local Rules of this Court, and filed with this Court

and delivered to counsel for the Receiver no later than **April 16, 2019**. If no objections or responses to the Recognition Petitions are timely filed, the Court may grant the relief requested without further notice.

Also on April 5, 2019, this Court held a hearing on the Receiver's Emergency Ex Parte Application for Temporary Restraining Order and Relief Pursuant to Sections 105(a) and 1519 of the Bankruptcy Code (Doc. 3) filed with respect to each of the Debtors, and granted the requested emergency provisional relief through midnight, April 19, 2019 ("TRO"). If any of the Recognition Petitions are opposed, the Court will also consider at the **April 18, 2019** hearing whether to extend the related TRO under Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b)(2), made applicable herein by Bankruptcy Rule 7065, or to grant a preliminary injunction under Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b)(3). Any objection to an extension of the TRO or request for preliminary relief shall be in writing, in compliance with the Bankruptcy Code and Rules, and the Local Rules of this Court, and filed with this Court and delivered to counsel for the Receiver no later than **April 16, 2019**.

Counsel for the Receiver shall serve this Notice, the relevant Recognition Petition and TRO on all parties entitled to notice under Bankruptcy Rule 2002(q), and file a certificate of such service.
