Introduction

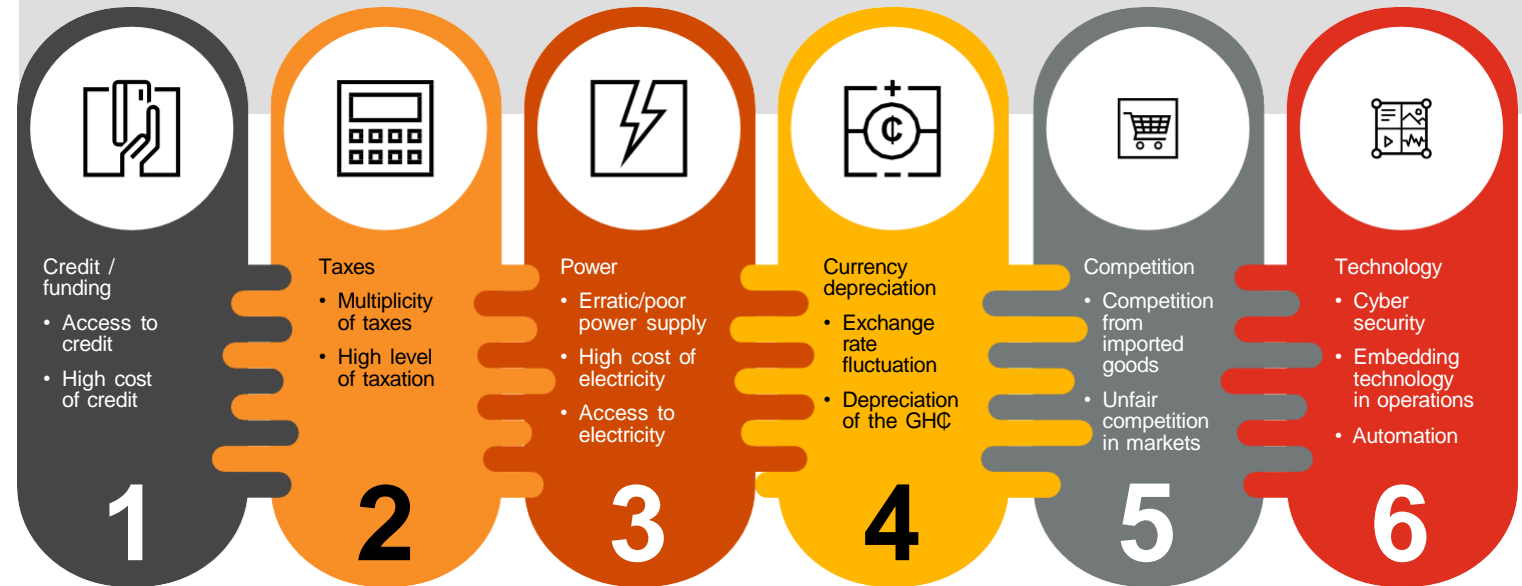
