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Increased minimum salary & Extension of digital work card transition

Ministerial Decision 25058/2024 of the Ministry of Labour and Social Security introduced an increase in the minimum salary for all employees in Greece. Additionally, Ministerial Decision 24595/2024 extends the transitional period for the digital work card in the industrial and retail sectors and defers the implementation of the ERGANI II revisions.

The key provisions of the above Decisions are summarised below:

Increase of minimum salary

Effective from 01.04.2024, the legal minimum salary for full-time employment is increased to:

- €830.00 monthly salary for employees (from €780.00); and
- €37.07 daily wage for blue-collar workers (from €34.84).

Extended digital work card transition

The Ministerial Decision extends the grace period for the implementation of the digital working card for both industrial and retail enterprises, during which no relevant administrative sanctions will be imposed, until 01.07.2024.

Deferred ERGANI II implementation

The new documents and amendments implemented in the Information System ERGANI II as per Ministerial Decision 113169/2023, will become accessible from 01.07.2024, allowing for phased adjustments within the Information System in the meantime.
