G4 is significantly different to the previous version as it places a greater focus on organisation's economic, environmental and social impacts. Materiality becomes the threshold at which relevant topics are deemed sufficiently important and therefore should be reported upon.

### The most important changes in G4:

- It's all about **materiality: organisations should** only report on their most material issues. They should also disclose their process to determine materiality
- **New supply chain disclosures for each** category (Economic, Environmental, Social): organisations should report in detail their supply chain management when material
- New disclosures for **Governance, Remuneration, Ethics and Integrity**
- More **focus on DMAs** (disclosures on management approach) by means of a generic DMA format
- Updated indicators for **Anti-Corruption and GHG emissions (aligned with GHG Protocol, scope 1, 2 and 3)**
- Application Levels replaced for two **“In Accordance” reporting options: Core and Comprehensive**
- New **GRI Context Index with separate column** for external assurance

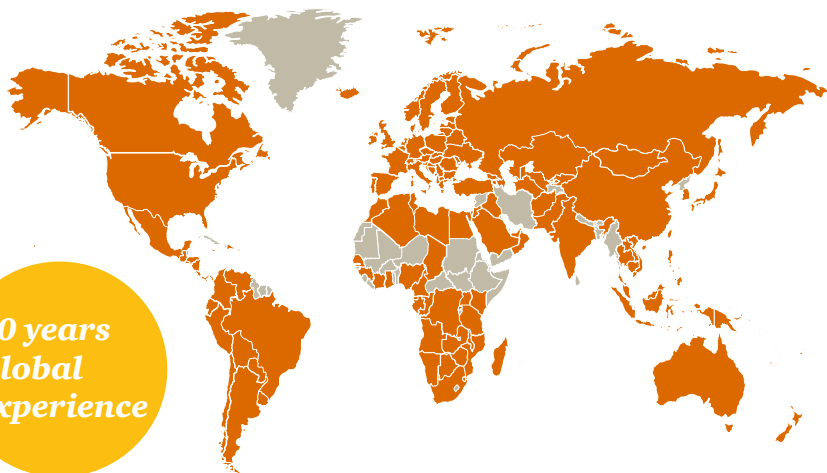
