Dominic Mills-Howell represents Jamaica as a “Young Global Changer” at G 20 Think Tank Summit in Germany

The scholarship programme aims at people with a passion for change and a background in social volunteering, academia, technology, start-ups journalism or blogging. By offering these scholarships, the summit wants to involve the views and ideas of the next generation into global problem-solving. Scholarship recipients will take part in a number of high-level side events and become part of an exclusive network of like-minded professionals.
