

Issue with apostilisation of Russian tax residency certificates is resolved

On 14 November 2016, President of the Republic of Kazakhstan Nursultan Nazarbayev signed Law “On ratification of an Agreement in form of exchange of notes with respect to order of acceptance of official documents confirming residence, which are issued by authorized bodies of Kazakhstan and Russia within the Treaty between the Government of Kazakhstan and Government of Russia on elimination of double taxation and prevention of evasion of income and capital tax payments (hereinafter – “Agreement”)”.

According to the Agreement, the documents issued and officially sealed by the authorized bodies of the government of one country should be accepted in the territory of another country without any special authorization, including apostilisation or consular legalization.
