In detail

Pursuant to Government Decree (#18-PGVR dated 9 March 2020), the labour authority has suspended the issuing of work permits for citizens of countries in categories 1(a), 1(b), and 2 (see below) related to coronavirus.

As of 11 March, entry into Kazakhstan is **prohibited** for citizens of countries in **category 1(a)**. For citizens of countries in **category 1(b)**, this limitation will be effective from **midnight 11/12 March**.

Citizens of countries of **category 2** must isolate themselves at their place of residence for 14 days.
