In detail:

Due to Omicron coronavirus variant spread, **Kazakhstan introduces restrictions starting from December 3:**

- **Entry to Kazakhstan will be restricted** for foreigners from the countries listed below:

Botswana	Madagascar	South Africa
Eswatini	Malawi	Tanzania
Hong Kong	Mozambique	Zimbabwe
Lesotho	Namibia	

- Individuals arriving from countries* where “Omicron strain” variant has been detected, should follow the requirements below:
 - ✓ **take PCR test, regardless of vaccination status**
 - ✓ **self-isolate for 7 days, regardless of PCR test results.**
- **Direct flights with Egypt will be suspended.**

*Current list of countries, where “omicron strain” was detected:

Israel, Czech Republic, Netherlands, Belgium, United Kingdom, Italy, Germany, Australia, Canada.
