In detail:

Pursuant to the **Order #17** of the Minister of Labour and Social Protection dated **18 January 2022**, the 2022 Quota for issuing of work permits to foreign personnel has been approved.

The **28,352 work permit units (0.31%** of the total Kazakhstan's workforce headcount) were released for foreign and seasonal employees for 2022. For comparison, last year the quota was **28,305 units**.

- II. Category - 6 499 units
- III. Category - 13 887 units
- IV. Category - 3 421 units
- Seasonal employees - 3 302 units
