The President signed the Decree on introduction of amendments to the Decree of the President of Kazakhstan dated 26 December 2019 No. 229 “On introduction of a moratorium on inspections and preventive control and supervision with a visit in Kazakhstan” (the “Decree”).

In details

According to the Decree, the moratorium on inspections and preventive control and supervision with a visit (which was previously announced from 1 January 2020 until 1 January 2023) has been canceled for inspections and preventive control for compliance with land legislation.

The Decree came into force on 11 August 2022.
