Foreign citizens with investor visas will no longer need to obtain a work permit from the local executive authorities.

## In details

The list of foreign nationals, who do not require permission from the local executive authorities to work, was extended by persons who received an investor visa. The changes do not apply to family members and dependents.

The changes will take effect on 24 September 2022.
