In detail

Below are listed main changes to the List:

- added official sources of information with regards to some of products:
 - *website of the London precious metals market associations (LBMA)* (www.lbma.org.uk) for precious metals;
 - *website of the London Stock Exchange metals (LME)* (www.lme.com) for non-ferrous metals;
 - *Argus Media Limited periodicals* with regards to rare earth metals, ferroalloys
- established official sources of information for goods for which the List previously had no sources:
 - *website of the London Stock Exchange metals (LME)* (www.lme.com) for zinc and lead;
 - *Fastmarkets MB (Metal Bulletin)* for selenium, antimony, cadmium, bismuth, telluride, rhenium
- excluded following periodicals from the List of official sources of information:
 - Ryan's Notes Ferrous and Nonferrous News and Prices;
 - Weekly Fax Service - Price Digest magazine;
 - Metal-pages
