## In brief

In connection with the state of emergency and measures to ensure socio-economic stability in Kazakhstan, the National Bank approved a Resolution to extend the deadlines for submission of certain reports (31 March 2020, Resolution No. 42).

## In detail

From 31 March 2020, to help business comply with regulatory requirements during the state of emergency, the National Bank extended the deadlines for submission of certain types of reports. Prolongation of deadlines for submission of reports applies, among others, to:

- Local banks, organizations carrying out certain types of banking activities, financial organizations and microfinance companies;
- Major Participants and Holdings of financial organizations;
- Insurance Payments Guarantee Fund JSC;
- Residents of Kazakhstan under currency control regulations;
- Residents of Kazakhstan under export-import operations.

Additionally, the effective date of the Resolution of the National Bank No. 267 (31 December 2019) (changes related to accounting) has been postponed until 1 July 2020.
