



## Updated requirements on provision of COVID-19 medical test result for expats entering Kazakhstan

### In detail

Pursuant to the Chief Sanitary Doctor's Decree **#39 (June 6, 2020)**, foreign nationals arriving in Kazakhstan should be isolated for **2 days** and pass a COVID-19 test. If the test result is negative, further isolation **is not required**.

Alternatively, isolation is not required for expats who provide a COVID-19 negative test, issued **no later than 5 days prior to entering Kazakhstan**.
