In detail

Currently, Kazakhstan borders are opened for nationals of countries which have direct flights to Kazakhstan specifically:

- Turkey;
- South Korea.

The key requirements are being citizens of these countries, direct flight to Kazakhstan and a valid Kazakhstan visa. Individuals do not require specific permission from the COVID-19 State Committee to enter Kazakhstan.

Currently, direct flights to Georgia and Thailand are expected to resume as of 1 August.

Countries where restrictions may be similarly relaxed in future include:

- Hungary
- India
- Czech Republic
- Malaysia
- Egypt
- Ukraine
- Poland
- Uzbekistan
- Kyrgyzstan
- Tajikistan
