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

Getting Qualified

To get your CMA qualification, you must meet the eligibility requirements which include passing 2 exams, Parts 1 and 2, and completing two continuous years of professional experience in management accounting. This requirement may be completed prior to, during or after passing the exams.

• The CMA exam consists of 2 parts, each of which is a 4 hour examination

- The exams consists of 100 MCQ's and 2 essay style questions
- The exams can be take in Jan/Feb, May/June, and Sept/Oct
- The minimum passing score is 360 out of 500 for each part

Minimum entry requirements

To get your CMA qualification, you must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Hold a bachelor's degree, in any discipline, from an accredited college or university
- Hold a CPA license or any other equivalent foreign professional qualification

How long does it take?

The CMA programme lets you proceed at your own pace. As there are only 2 exams it is possible to complete your CMA in 6-12 months.


