

# ***New regulations on employee business travel***

*16 May 2014*

## ***In brief***

The Government of the Republic of Moldova has approved new amendments to the Regulations on delegation within the country and abroad for employees of Moldovan entities.

---

## ***In detail***

The main amendments to the Regulation on the delegation of employees of Moldovan entities relate to the following:

- the employee business trip period is limited to 60 calendar days;
- the amount of per diem for arrival and departure days is equal to 50% of the established rates;
- if the delegated person is granted financial resources in the form of per diem, scholarships or other payments aimed at covering current expenses, the employer does not pay the established per diem, but compensates for the difference if the funds granted by other entities are less than the established per diem.

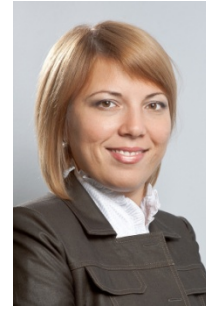
