- 2. The services will be offered at all branches of the bank and will initially consist of:
 - a) cash withdrawal from savings and/or current accounts in amounts not exceeding Rs 50,000 per account per day;
 - b) encashment of cheques over the counter in amounts not exceeding Rs 50,000 per account per day; and
 - c) cash deposits.
- 3. The services will be provided under the control of the Receivers and under the oversight and supervision of SBM Bank (Mauritius) Ltd.
- 4. This is a short-term transitional arrangement pending the resumption of full-fledged banking services. Customers and the public in general will be kept informed of further developments.
