- Preference for fields such as accounting, accounting and finance, computer science, information technology, cybersecurity, data analytics or equivalent.
- Currently enrolled in the first year of an undergraduate programme at a recognised higher learning institution in Malaysia, at any stage of the academic semester.
- Not receiving any other scholarships or equivalents.
- Applications are open to students from both public and private universities based in Malaysia.
