Finance (No. 2) Bill 2023 Passed at Dewan Rakyat

The Finance (No. 2) Bill 2023 (the “Bill”) was passed by the Dewan Rakyat on 28 November 2023. No material difference is noted from the copy of the Bill at Parliament’s website as compared to the version that was first read at Parliament on 7 November 2023.

Please note that the Bill is still pending the passing by Dewan Negara (Senate) and royal assent by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong before it becomes law.
