Finance Bill 2023 has been passed at the Dewan Negara

The Finance Bill 2023 ("Bill") was passed at the Dewan Negara on 10 April 2023 with no difference from the amended Bill which was passed by the Dewan Rakyat on 3 April 2023 (please refer to [TaXavvy 5/2023](#) for details).

The Bill is now pending royal assent by His Majesty Seri Paduka Baginda Yang Di-Pertuan Agong before it becomes law.
