- Other requirements include proficiency in English, strong communication skills, logical thinking to solve problems, working knowledge of technology, good social skills, and be able to work well in a team;
- Students who obtained a bursary from another financial institution that requires the student to complete work after studies, will not qualify for a PwC bursary;
- Shortlisted candidates will be subject to a personality and aptitude test.
