## Category 3 – Up to 50% on site, 50% work from home






## Category 4 – Not allowed to operate







Massage parlors, sauna baths, facial and foot spa and waxing salons





Van – 8 persons allowed




Buses – 50% total capacity

# General Community Quarantine

Allowed, with conditions

**Road, rail, maritime,

starting 7 June,  
subject to minimum  
health protocols**



**Dine-in restaurants  
and the like are  
allowed but limited  
to 50% of total  
customer capacity**



**Outdoor  
non-contact sports  
(e.g. walking,  
jogging) are  
allowed** while  
observing minimum  
health standards



**Essential private and  
public construction**  
(e.g. sewerage, water  
services, digital works,  
health facilities, priority  
projects)

# General Community Quarantine

Not allowed, with exceptions



**Persons aged below 21 years, 60 years and above, immunodeficient, with comorbidities, or pregnant** are not allowed to go out except when going out for essentials



**No hotels or similar establishments,** with certain exceptions



**No physical classes**, except for certain allowances for higher education institutions



**No mass gatherings,** except for essential work and religious gatherings with health protocols observed

Not allowed



**Amusement, gaming, fitness, kids and tourism establishments may not operate**
