



# PwC's National Accounting Teacher Award 2019

A candidate for PwC's National Accounting Teacher of the Year should be an exceptionally dedicated, knowledgeable, and skilled teacher in accounting\* in a university or college. A candidate should be a distinguished model of excellence who helped uplift the standards of the teaching profession.

The award is presented by PwC Philippines/Isla Lipana & Co. in cooperation with the National Association of CPAs in Education (naCPAe).

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\*Auditing, Management Advisory Services, Taxation, Regulatory Framework for Business Transactions, Financial Accounting and Reporting, and Advanced Financial Accounting and Reporting (AFAR)

## Mechanics

### Nomination

#### Who can be nominated

1. Must be a CPA and currently teaching accountancy subjects (ie. Auditing, Management Advisory Services, Taxation, Regulatory Framework for Business Transactions, Financial Accounting and Reporting, and Advanced Financial Accounting and Reporting (AFAR) in a university or college at the time of nomination.
2. With relevant teaching experience of at least 3 units and/or 5 months.

#### Who can nominate

1. School / College Dean
2. Self-nomination
3. Student nomination

#### How to nominate

#### Accomplish the Nomination form (Starting 19 February 2019)

- Short profile of the nominee (one nomination form per nominee)
- 300-word essay why the nominee deserves the award and should highlight:
  - The ability of the teacher to inspire students from all backgrounds and abilities.
  - Commands respect from colleagues, students, and parents.

- Teacher's impact in the community beyond the classroom.
- Any awards and recognitions received by the teacher.
- Self-nomination and Student nomination forms will require a recommendation from the school's dean.
- PwC will regularly update the nominator of the required number of students' feedback.

## **Student Feedback**

### **Feedback forms**

- PwC will generate a Feedback form for each school that receives official nominees from the Nomination forms.
- The Feedback form will be regularly updated to accommodate a school's additional official nominees.
- The link to the Feedback form will be provided to the nominators, where students can access the link and give their feedbacks.

### **Feedback process**

- Students can only give feedback for their school nominees.
- Students may choose to accomplish a Feedback form for each of the school nominees.
- A nominee requires a minimum of 20 feedbacks in order to be qualified for shortlisting.

### **Last day of collecting Feedback**

Feedbacks shall be received until 20 March 2019.

## **Shortlisting of nominees**

### **Screening panel**

- The screening panel will consist of four to five PwC team members.
- The panel shall select the grand winner and two runners-up from the five (5) shortlisted nominees.

### **Screening and judging criteria**

1. Length of teaching experience
2. Inclusiveness rating (from survey/testimonials of students and peers)
3. Nominator's perspectives on the teachers extra ordinary traits (essay by the nominator)
4. Recognition/awards received from school, industry, community.
5. Interview of the finalists

**Submitted forms will undergo verification process by the screening committee. The nomination will be withdrawn if the nominee fails to receive the 20 required minimum number of student feedbacks and secure the school dean's recommendation.**

## **Final round panel interview**

### **Panel of judges**

Seven members will composed the Panel of Judges to determine the 2019 National Accounting Teacher Award representing PwC, Commission on Higher Education, naCPAe, members of the Philippine Senate and Congress and the Board of Accountancy.

## **Awarding of winners and prizes**

The winners will be announced during the naCPAe's 2019 National Convention on 29 April 2019.

### **Winners**

- Grand winner: 2019 National Accounting Teacher Award
- Two runners-up

### **Prizes**

Trophies and cash prizes will be given to the winners. The awardees' schools and nominators shall also receive special prizes (no special prize will be given to self-nominated winners).

- The 2019 National Accounting Teacher Award Grand Winner: PHP100,000.00
  - Special prize for school: PHP75,000
  - Special prize for nominator: PHP25,000
- The 2019 National Accounting Teacher Award Runner-up: PHP50,000
  - Special prize for school: PHP35,000
  - Special prize for nominator: PHP15,000
