

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Eligibility Conditions

- Subsidy is only applicable to business entities registered and operating in Singapore, with a minimum of 30% local shareholding.
- Participants must be nominated by their company as the company's representatives for participation in this series of Sustainability Courses.
- Companies will be supported for 70% of the costs of up to 3 company representatives to participate in these sustainability courses in total.
- Each individual will only be supported to participate in these sustainability courses once.
- Company is liable to make full payment for the course fees if company or participants are found to be ineligible or fail to complete the course

- **Who is eligible for the subsidies?**

To be eligible for subsidies, enterprises have to be a business entity registered and operating in Singapore with a minimum of 30% local shareholding. Large Local Enterprises (LLEs) that meet this criteria qualify for the subsidised course fee. Foreign enterprises and other organisations are not eligible.

- **Can participants from non-eligible entities attend the course? (E.g. participants from MNCs, Trade Associations, NGOs, etc.)**

ESG is not able to provide course fee subsidy for non-eligible business entities (e.g. MNCs) and non-business entities (e.g. trade associations, NGOs, etc) to attend the course. As such, participants from non-eligible enterprises can attend the course but will have to pay the full course fee. As the course is intended for SMEs, priority will be given to SMEs.

- **Are foreign individuals eligible for subsidies?**

Foreign individuals are eligible for subsidies, as long as they are nominated by an eligible enterprise.

- **Can enterprises apply for more subsidies beyond the subsidised fee of \$450?**

No, no further subsidies are available.

- **Who is the target audience for the course?**

Enterprises that are new to sustainability and would like to raise business understanding of sustainability. The courses are curated for business leaders/ c-suite/ managerial lead.

- **Will an individual enjoy subsidies if he/she attends more than one training partner's course?**

No, each individual will only be supported to participate in one ESP-Sustainability Course.

- **Do participants from the same enterprise have to attend the same run/ courses by the same training partner to enjoy the subsidized rate?**

No, participants can decide and attend courses by their preferred training partner as long as the total participants per eligible enterprise is capped at 3 and that this is the only course under ESP - Sustainability Courses series that they have attended.
