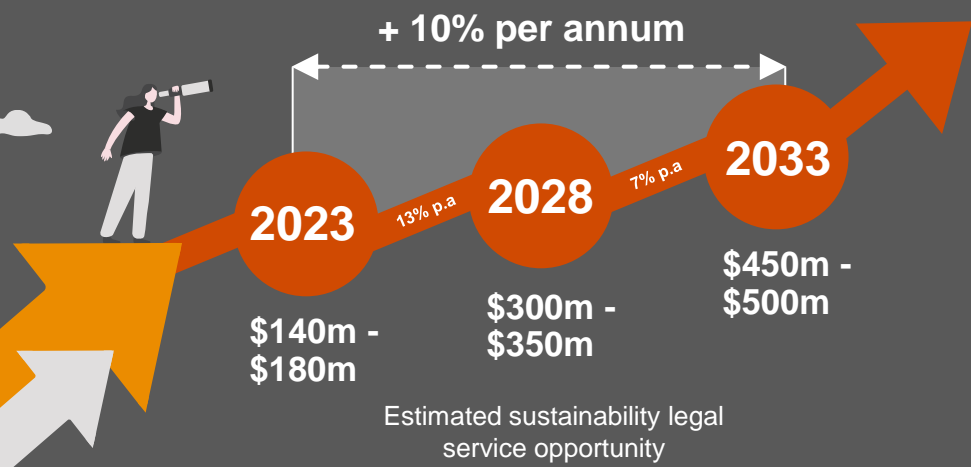


Report on Sustainability-ready Singapore Lawyers
