Announcing the 2nd year of the grant programme "Yes, students can!"

PwC is announcing the second year of the grant programme for students of colleges and universities "Yes, students can!". Our aim is to draw students' attention to the importance of corporate social responsibility (CSR) and provide students who are active in this field, an opportunity for realisation of their own CSR project.

The programme is designed for students of all colleges and universities in Slovakia. The deadline for submitting grant applications is 16 March 2014. PwC will support five projects by a grant in a value of **EUR 800**.

The list of projects we have supported in the first year of the programme in 2013, may bean interesting inspiration for the applicants:

- Easily accessible and uniform exchange of books facilitating the sale and purchase of used books for students of University of Economics in Bratislava through a single website.
- **KECY Orava camp** the third annual summer English-Slovak conversational camp aimed at teaching English and community development for young people in the Orava region.
- NÁBOJ an international competition for school teams in solving mathematical and logical tasks.
- **SCI_ARCH**: Architecture of sci-fi movies or future reality? lectures, seminars and workshops running during an exhibition of sci-fi movies' buildings and interiors. The project presents the future possibilities of existing architecture.
- Wintering animals in the yard of our kindergarten familiarising children in kindergartens around Hlohovec with winter insects and birds.
- **Step forward!** a project to train youth leaders to implement free-time activities for young people aged 14 to 25 years.
- Student jails the objective of the project is to highlight the problems of university colleges in Bratislava and to create a competition for the worst-looking of Bratislava's dormitories. Funds from the grant will be used to improve the "winner" to a more acceptable form.
