

PwC Thailand's 60th Anniversary Charity Run: Restore Vision, Run for Sight

Event Terms and Conditions

1. Acceptance of conditions

1.1. For the wellbeing of all participants, and of the PwC Thailand's 60th Anniversary Charity Run: Restore Vision, Run for Sight ("the Event"), all participants must accept and comply with all event terms and conditions of PricewaterhouseCoopers ABAS Ltd.

1.2 I/We accept that it is my/our responsibility to contact the event organisers at PAPA Event Co., Ltd. should any information on my/our Registration Form need to be updated.

2. Route variation

2.1. The organisers of the Event reserve the right to vary the route of the Event without notice, should any situation requiring such action arise.

3. Expected behaviour

3.1. All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a manner which reflects well upon themselves and the Event. Participants will show respect towards all event officials, organisers and safety personnel. A belief in what a reasonable person would find offensive or dangerous will guide the organisers' decision making.

4. Preparation and training

4.1. It is each participant's responsibility to ensure that they have adequately prepared themselves physically for the Event. If you have any health issues or doubts about your health, you should seek medical advice. The participants are fully aware that the participants are in good health and have physical readiness to participate in this event. Please ensure you take any necessary medication with you during the Event, and all necessary equipment used in the Event are appropriate condition for the course.

5. Event information

5.1. The event organisers publish a number of documents, in the form of briefing and information documents and on the Event website pwc.com/th/60th-anniversary-charity-run. It is each participant's responsibility to ensure you read and understand all information made available to you and to the general public.

5.2 The organisers of the Event collect and store participants personal and contact information, including email address and phone number. Participants agree that these information may be used to contact you regarding the Event.

6. Safety

6.1. All participants must remain vigilant at all times to your own safety and the safety of others on the roads and other places. Participants acknowledge that there is no guarantee that other members of the public will necessarily respect or obey the road rules. Participants must comply with all directions of event officials, organisers, safety personnel and with all the Event signage.

6.2. Each participant accepts that despite the best efforts of the organisers to make the Event as safe as they can, the organisers cannot control everything, and it is your own duty of care to remain yourself and belongings safe at any time throughout the activities of the event.

6.3 All participants may not use a personal electronic device, e.g. iPod, or a radio communication device, including a cellular phone, while participating in the Event, on roads or while crossing roads.

6.4. Any participant must notify the organisers if withdrawing from the Event for any reason either prior to or during the Event.

6.5. It is the responsibility of all participants to arrange personal insurance to cover any accident, harm to health, potential damage, or loss of equipment while participating in the Event.

7. Legal issues

7.1. Any participant involved in an accident will not seek to blame or make a claim against the organisers or assist anyone else in making a claim.

7.2. Each participant will release the organisers, their officers, partners, employees or any party associated with the Event of any liability, financial or otherwise, for any direct or indirect loss, injury or death which might be sustained from any intended or actual participation in the Event or its related activities.

7.3. Any legal action related to the Event will be settled by discussion and negotiation in good faith, and if it is unsuccessfully resolved by negotiation, it will be taken to arbitration in Thailand under Thai laws.

7.4. These terms and conditions are binding on participants' relatives, personal representatives, heirs and successors.

8. Photography

8.1. Participants must accept that they may be photographed or filmed during the Event, and must agree to the creation and use of such footage for future promotions and publicity of the Event. Participants also agree that PwC Thailand can use imagery of participants.

9. Registration fee and cancellations

9.1. In the event of a change of route, cancellation of the Event due to any act beyond the power of the organisers, or dissatisfaction, the organisers are under no obligation to refund fees paid.

10. Signing on behalf of others

10.1. If you are completing the Registration Form on behalf of others, then you must have them read and acknowledge the Event terms and conditions and obtain their permission to enter into this Event on their behalf. By making the below Declaration, you will be deemed to be also making it on behalf of those persons and with their authority, and they will be bound by the Event terms and conditions as if they had personally signed the Declaration.

You agree to comply with any applicable law and regulation of Thailand governing the use of the information and agree to give consent as may be required by applicable laws and regulations when providing us with such information. During and after this Event you will take all reasonable steps to ensure that any personal information is protected against misuse and loss, or unauthorised access, modification or disclosure and do all things to ensure that neither you, nor we, breach applicable privacy laws.
