**Implementation of export control measures for dual-use items will be delayed to 2019**

### Summary :



An MOC notification on 20 December 2017 confirmed the delay of export control measures for dual-use items. Implementation was originally scheduled for 1 January 2018 but is now due to start **1 January 2019**. The two control lists in the original notification are still valid.

Despite the delay, companies are recommended to continue reviewing their products to ensure that they're ready for implementation. Preparation during 2018 will help reduce potential disruption and the risk of significant fines in 2019.
