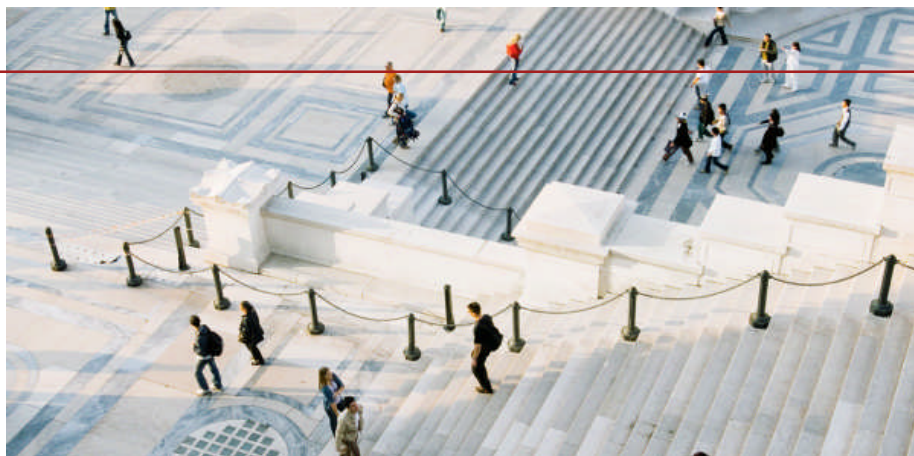

Special customs duties for imported vehicles

The Ukrainian government has carried out an investigation of the importation of motor vehicles into Ukraine and has concluded that within the past few years the volume of such imports has increased greatly, causing significant damage to the national auto manufacturers. Therefore, the government has introduced special customs duties for the import of new vehicles, regardless of the country of their origin or export:

- for vehicles with an engine capacity 1000 - 1500 cc - 6,46 % ad valorem
- for vehicles with an engine capacity 1500 - 2200 cc - 12,95 % ad valorem

These rates of duty shall apply for three years, apart from the normal customs duties for imported vehicles.

The decision of the Ukrainian government was officially published on 14 March 2013, and shall come into force 30 days after the date of publication.
