New Work Permit procedure

On 5 July 2013 the Resolution* on the new procedure on issuing work permits (WP) came into force. According to the Resolution, the list of required documents has slightly changed:

- a couple fewer documents from the company, but
- one more certificate from the individual (a medical certificate confirming the absence of narcomania/alcoholism and some other diseases).

The Resolution prescribes the full list of required documents along with the grounds for cancelling or not issuing a WP.

There are some practical questions on the sequence of the required steps and the deadlines for each step. We will keep you informed about the interpretation of the Resolution and its practical application.
